THE PHONE CALL

A fraudster telephones you claiming to be from your bank or the police. They say there is a problem with your bank account or bank card. They suggest you hang up and ring the bank/police back to ensure the call is genuine. Don't be fooled – they stay on the line.



THE PIN NUMBER/ CASH WITHDRAWAL

You are then either required to give them your PIN or they will ask you to attend your bank to make a large cash withdrawal to assist the bogus investigation. They will tell you not to tell anyone or discuss this with your bank.



THE COURIER

They send a taxi/courier to you to collect your bank card or the cash you've just withdrawn. You've just become a victim of Courier Fraud.

JUST REMEMBER: Your bank or the police will never ask for your PIN or bank card – don't give them to anybody!
